RECOUNT PETITION OBJECTIONS

Pursuant to MCL 168.868, I, Michelle L. Hemeyer, do hereby make the following objections to the November 18, 2022 Petition for Recount filed by Gregory Keller as to the votes cast for the Hartland Consolidated Schools, Board Member, at the November 8, 2022 election:

1. There is no evidence of any error, fraud or mistake in the voting process or count regarding the election in question.
2. No reputable media outlets have reported any error, fraud or mistake in the voting process or count regarding the election in question.
3. Mr. Keller has failed to provide any factual basis for his "good faith belief" of an error, fraud or mistake in the voting process or count regarding the election in question.
4. Mr. Keller has tellingly failed to complete the section of the Petition for a Recount in which he could have provided an explanation of any alleged fraud or error, thereby tacitly admitting the specious nature of his request.
5. The recount demanded by Mr. Keller would constitute a substantial expense of between \$10,000-\$12,000 to the School District and thereby constitute a pointless waste of valuable taxpayer dollars while also unfairly depriving our children of funds which would be more responsibly spent on their education.
6. Mr. Keller's disappointment with the election result is not reason enough to force the citizens of this School District to waste precious time, money, and other resources.

For all these reasons, I request that Mr. Keller's Petition for Recount be rejected in its entirety and that no recount take place.
