#### CMH/Veteran's Court Program

- Employ specialized master's level therapist to meet the needs of veteran population
  - Licensed master's social worker
  - CAADC desirable
  - o Experience and/or knowledge of the unique needs of veterans and VA system
  - Skillsets in trauma, substance abuse, Veteran's Court, CBT
- Split Therapist II position: 0.5 FTE veteran program and 0.5 FTE unfrozen CIP program
- Direct referral from Veterans Service Office and Veteran's Treatment Court to the program bypassing normal CMH intake process, similar to other court and jail programs
- Therapist will provide an array of services to Veteran's/Court participants with moderate to severe mental health needs and co-occurring substance use needs
- Therapist will be an active participant with Veteran's Court Team by attending team meetings weekly; participating in Court sessions; reporting on participant progress; and providing services to meet the mental health and substance use needs of participants.
- Therapy modalities:
  - Individual therapy
  - Case management services within the scope of therapy sessions
  - o Group therapy to focus on SUD, trauma and mental health
  - Coordination with Veteran's Court Team
  - Referral to and coordination with VA health resources and other community health resources as appropriate
- Additional services may be provided based on need including:
  - Mental health assistant or peer support services with veteran experience
  - o Psychiatric consultation and medication review
  - Nursing support for medication

### Funding plan and capacity:

- Participants do not require a specific insurance. Participants may choose to utilize CMH services in lieu of other resources (like VA mental health services) to support their needs.
- If participants meet typical CMH eligibility and have Medicaid, they will be served under our capitation and not under the Veteran's Court Project
- 0.5 FTE Therapist II can provide up to 5 hours of Court team time per week and 10-15 hours of direct service time.
- Documentation will be streamlined to maximize direct service time

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
