Re: Resolution Authorizing the Submission of the Livingston County Public Defender's FY2022 Compliance Plan and Grant Request to the Michigan Indigent Defense Commission (MIDC) Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA) to Request Funding to Comply with the Michigan Indigent Defense Act, Public Act 214 of 2018 – Public Defender

The Michigan Indigent Defense Commission has issued mandated minimum standards 1-5 for Indigent Defense Services in the State of Michigan. The State of Michigan, through the MIDC, will provide funding to assist with compliance of the mandated standards. The MIDC funding is contingent upon the terms of an approved Compliance Plan. The Public Defender's Office is seeking approval to submit the attached Compliance Plan and Grant Request to the MIDC for fiscal year 2022 which runs from October 1, 2021 until September 30, 2022.
