

## Bid Synopsis For Airport Snow Removal Services

The Evaluation Committee has completed evaluation of the bids received for the Request for Quote referenced above. Below is a recap of the bid evaluation.

The RFQ was publicly posted. One response was received from Anglin Civil LLC.

Even though only one proposal was received, the RFP was publicly posted on two websites. As a result, the bid documents were downloaded by 18 qualified companies. While only one (1) qualified submission was received, the Evaluation Committee believes that the process created a system of free and open competition and should be considered valid.

Anglin Civil submitted their response within the timeframe outlined in the RFP. A summary of the review follows:

Anglin Civil provided a complete company history, indicating that it was established in 2008 with a focus on airfield snow removal. They have focused on perfecting the process of safely, efficiently, and effectively removing snow and ice from the Airport Operations Area (AOA) side of class 1 and smaller airports. They employ around 200 operators with as much as 30 years of snow removal experience. Anglin Civil submitted the required signed company profile, the required references which are recent and relevant, a signed checklist, and notarized PA 517 Certificate of Compliance. A signed acknowledgement of the addendum was also submitted as required.

It was required that the bidder provide photographs of their equipment, and it is clear that Anglin Civil is able to provide the equipment required in the RFP.

A review of the pricing provided by Anglin Civil reflected slightly higher prices than the previous contract; however, the slight increase is determined to be reasonable.

Based on the above evaluation, it is recommended that a contract be awarded to Anglin Civil LLC for a three-year period with the option of two one-year renewals at the discretion of the county.
