\$39,900.

WHEREAS, this cost exceeds the value for departmental approval and requires the approval of the board.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners hereby authorize the Livingston County

Emergency Medical Services to complete the necessary repairs to the foam fire suppression

system in the hangar portion of the EMS building with the total cost of the repair to be billed to

The Regents of the University of Michigan per the current lease agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Livingston County Board of Commissioners authorize any budget

amendments necessary to effectuate the above.
