Re: Resolution Authorizing the Livingston County Juvenile Court to Accept Funding

from the Michigan Supreme Court, State Court Administrative Office Child Welfare Services, Court Improvement Program COVID-19 Supplemental Grant

Congress has granted one-time supplemental Court Improvement Program (CIP) funding to the Michigan Supreme Court to address the unique challenges facing juvenile courts stemming from the COVID-19 public health emergency to ensure that the safety, permanency, and well-being needs of children in foster care are met in a timely manner. The Michigan Supreme Court, through the State Court Administrative Office Child Welfare Services Division (SCAO-CWS), invited local courts to apply for up to \$30,000 per court to address four purpose areas:

- 1. Administrative Solutions to Resolve Backlog of Child Protection Cases Due to Covid-19
- 2. Access to Technology to Increase Party Participation
- 3. Compensate Attorneys to Attend Out of Court Client Meetings or Handle Ancillary Legal Matters to Expedite Safe Permanency
- 4. Other strategies to help avoid delays in legal proceedings or to assist juvenile courts with needs that have resulted from COVID-19

Pursuant to Resolution 2021-11-171, the Court requested \$30,000 to fund four mini-projects in purpose areas 2 – 4 (providing internet access to families; compensating attorneys for out of court client meetings and providing ancillary legal service; providing additional Bailiff/Court Security hours to support the mobile courtroom and expanding the Court Appointed Special Advocates program).

SCAO-CWS has elected to fund two of the four mini-projects – Access to Technology for Families and Attorney Compensation – in an amount not to exceed \$17,000 for the period of January 1, 2022 – September 30, 2022. No County match or cost-sharing is required. No additional staff positions are included to carry out this grant.
