Resolution Authorizing the Acceptance of the 2022 Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding (CESF) Grant – Livingston County Trial Courts

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding (CESF) grant is funded from the United States Department of Justice as appropriated in the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, authorized by Division B of H.R. 748, Pub. L. No. 116136 (Emergency Appropriations for Coronavirus Health Response and Agency Operations); 28 U.S.C. 530C, and administered by the Michigan State Police; and

- **WHEREAS,** the purpose of the grant is to provide emergency supplemental funding to Michigan circuit, district, and probate courts to respond to the coronavirus pandemic; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to the Resolution 2021-12-181 a grant application was submitted and the Livingston County Trial Courts have been awarded \$159,948 with NO LOCAL MATCH; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Michigan State Police has approved the use of grant funds for the probate OnBase project, thereby freeing ARPA funds allocated for the project in the 2022 Livingston County Budget (Resolution 2021-12-194); and
- WHEREAS, an agreement exists between Livingston County and the vendor ImageSoft for OnBase services and a Statement of Work for probate OnBase has been developed between ImageSoft, Livingston County IT and Livingston County Courts and reviewed by Civil Counsel; and
- WHEREAS, no new positions are required or requested for this grant.
- **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Livingston County Board of Commissioners approves the acceptance of the 2022 Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding Grant to the Michigan State Police in the amount of \$159,948, with a term of January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chair of the Livingston County Board of Commissioners is authorized to sign all forms, assurances, contracts, agreements, future amendments for monetary and contract language adjustments and supporting documents related to the above upon review and / or preparation of Civil Counsel.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chair of the Livingston County Board of Commissioners is authorized to sign the ImageSoft Statement of Work as reviewed and approved by Civil Counsel.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Livingston County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes any budget amendment to effectuate the above.
