Resolution Authorizing an Amendment to the Contract with Tiggs Canteen to Increase Inmate Meal Cost – Jail

WHEREAS, The Livingston County Sheriff's Office has been under an inmate food contract with Tiggs Canteen since 2015; and

WHEREAS, in 2020, the food contract went out to RFP with Tiggs being the only vendor to submit a bid and ultimately be awarded the contract; and

WHEREAS, Tiggs provides three (3) meals per day to the inmates housed in the Livingston County Jail with meal cost dependent on the ADP (average daily population); and

WHEREAS, Tiggs is suffering a hardship due to inflation and the rising food costs; and

WHEREAS, Tiggs is requesting an increase of \$0.32 per tray, per meal (see chart for price breakdown); and

ADP	Current Breakdown	Proposed Breakdown
0 – 250	\$1.185	\$1.505
251 – 299	\$1.145	\$1.465
300+	\$1.105	\$1.425

WHEREAS, this increase would allow Tiggs Canteen to continue to provide quality food service to the inmates which is a necessity in maintaining the safety and security of the Jail.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Livingston County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes an amendment to the Inmate Food contract with Tiggs Canteen for an increase of \$0.32 per tray, per meal retroactive to June 1, 2022 until December 31, 2022.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Livingston County Board of Commissioners is authorized to sign all forms, assurances, contracts/agreements, renewals and future amendments for monetary and contract language adjustments related to the above upon review and/or preparation of Civil Counsel.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Livingston County Board of Commissioners authorizes any budget amendment necessary to effectuate this contract amendment.
