Resolution Authorizing an Agreement with Ameel Trabilsy II for Juvenile Drug Court Attorney Services – Court Central Services

WHEREAS, Livingston County Juvenile Drug Court has a need for Attorney Services; and

WHEREAS, the current contract expires on December 31st, 2022; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the County's Procurement Policy, a formal bid process was performed and one (1) proposal was received and evaluated to provide attorney services to the Juvenile Drug Court for the period of January 1st, 2023 through December 31st, 2023, with the option of renewal for up to two additional one-year periods; and

WHEREAS, Ameel Trabilsy, II, has met the requirements to provide the Juvenile Drug Court with attorney services; and

WHEREAS, through funding from the Juvenile Drug Court SCAO grant, the Courts will have the flexibility to award a contract to the above vendor based on program requirements and the Court's needs with an anticipated start date of January 1, 2023.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Livingston County Board of Commissioners hereby authorize entering into a contract for attorney services with Ameel Trabilsy, II, beginning January 1st, 2023 and continue until December 31st, 2023, with the ability to renew the contract at the Court's discretion for up to two additional one-year periods.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chair of the Livingston County Board of Commissioners is authorized to sign the contracts and contract extensions referenced above and any future amendments for monetary and contractual language upon review by Civil Counsel.
