





Bid Synopsis For Attorney Services for Juvenile Drug Court

The Evaluation Committee has completed evaluation of the proposal received for the Request for Proposals referenced above. The purpose of the RFP is to secure legal representation services for Juvenile Drug Court participants, and competitively award a contract that will provide these services for the next three years. Below is a recap of the bid evaluation.

The RFP was publicly posted on two websites and, as a result, over 84 qualified companies were notified of the solicitation. Even though only one qualified submission was received, the Evaluation Committee believes that the process created a system of free and open competition and should be considered valid.

The response was received from Ameel Trabilsy II. It was received within the timeline outlined in the RFP. All documents received were reviewed for compliance with the minimum requirements, and all required forms, signatures, and notarizations were included.

The Evaluation Committee independently reviewed and scored the proposal. Mr. Trabilsy has been providing attorney services to Livingston County for over 10 years. The service provided has been excellent and there have been no performance issues. The pricing submitted by Mr. Trabilsy is on par with the current rate paid to attorneys for the Juvenile Drug Court.

Based on the above, the evaluation committee recommends award to Ameel Trabilsy II pending Board of Commissioners approval.
