## **Resolution Authorizing an Increase in Total Authorized Vehicles for the Sheriff's Office Field Services Division for Additional Deputies – Car Pool**

- **WHEREAS,** Resolution 2021-02-019 authorized the Sheriff's Office Field Services Division to increase its fleet of Patrol vehicles by 14 to implement the Deputy Assigned Vehicle (DAV) Program, bringing the Patrol fleet to 40 vehicles and the total Field Services fleet count to 64 vehicles; and
- **WHEREAS,** Resolution 2022-05-066 subsequently authorized the hiring of two (2) additional uniformed deputies in 2022 and one (1) additional uniformed deputy in 2023; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Sheriff's Office Field Services Division is requesting the addition of three (3) Patrol vehicles to its fleet for the additional deputy positions, which will increase the Patrol fleet to 43 vehicles and the total Field Services fleet count to 67 vehicles; and
- **WHEREAS,** the additional Patrol vehicles will be leased through Enterprise Fleet Management for a term of 60 months but may be turned in early without penalty if the number of authorized deputy positions is reduced; and
- WHEREAS, estimated annual costs for lease payments, fuel, maintenance, and insurance are \$16,500 per vehicle and are included in the Department's 2023 budget request.
- **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Livingston County Board of Commissioners hereby approves an increase in total authorized vehicles for the Sheriff's Office Field Services Division from sixty-four (64) vehicles to sixty-seven (67) vehicles.
