Re: Resolution to Authorize Agreement for Delivery of Comprehensive Health Services for the Period of October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023

The attached resolution establishes continuation of the agreement with the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services for the delivery of mandated comprehensive health services. The MDHHS provides funding to partially reimburse the county for services covered in the agreement. There have been no significant changes in program requirements. The changes seen in funding from our 2022 resolution includes increases in Emergency Preparedness and WIC programs in the amount totaling \$38,546.
