## Resolution Authorizing Specialty Courts and Programs to Apply for the State Opioid Response 2 Project (SOR2) Grant for the Adult Drug Court for FY 2023 Court Central Services

> WHEREAS, The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) authorizes the expenditure of federal funds with the State Court Administrative office (SCAO) by awarding competitive grant awards to provide treatment services for opioid and methamphetamine use through Treatment Court Programs and has identified funds to be awarded for FY2023 that does not require a cash match; and

WHEREAS, Livingston County's $44^{\text {th }}$ Circuit and $53^{\text {rd }}$ District Courts constitute a jurisdiction designated to operate Specialty Courts and Programs; and

WHEREAS, Specialty Courts and Programs is seeking approval to apply for the SOR2 grant funding for FY2023, in an approximate amount of $\$ 75,000$, to be used for treatment services to participants with opioid and methamphetamine use disorders in our Adult Drug Court and funding for existing positions; and

WHEREAS, there are no new positions requested for this grant.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Livingston County Board of Commissioners authorizes Specialty Court and Programs to apply for the FY2023 State Opioid Response 2 Project (SOR2) grant, in an approximate amount of $\$ 75,000$, from the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) through SCAO.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Livingston County Board of Commissioners is authorized to sign all forms, assurances, contracts/agreements, and future amendments for Monetary and contract language adjustments related to the above grant application upon review and/or preparation of Civil Counsel.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, if awarded, the Specialty Courts and Programs will come back before the Livingston County Board of Commissioners to accept the grant award.
