## **Resolution Approving the Purchase of a Mobile Fingerprint Readers and Distribution of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funding– Livingston County Sheriff's Office**

- WHEREAS, Resolution 2022-12-192 outlined a plan for the strategic use and distribution of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding; and WHEREAS, a total of \$1,750,000 of ARPA funding was identified for the Livingston County Sheriff's Office for projects: and WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office is requesting \$6,484 of this allocation for the purpose of purchasing new mobile fingerprint readers. The current readers are no longer complaint with the Federal Bureau of Investigation's Criminal Justice Information Services guidelines and must be replaced; and WHEREAS, this is an eligible use of ARPA funding and will be listed under the *Expenditure Category*: 6.1 / Provision of Government Services for federal reporting purposes. THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Livingston County Board of Commissioners hereby approves the \$6,484 in ARPA funds to purchase new mobile fingerprint readers for the purpose of more efficiently identifying personnel involved with the Sheriff's office and remaining compliant with common law enforcement standards.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board of Commissioners authorizes any budget amendments need to effectuate this project.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that from the date of approval of this resolution until the project is completed, as outlined in Resolution 2022-12-192, the Sheriff's Office shall provide a written update on the status of the project every three (3) months and shall present, in person, to the Finance and Asset Management Committee every six (6) months until the project is complete.
