After careful consideration, we have determined that the greatest need the Brighton Senior Center has at this time is staffing a part-time activities coordinator. Adding this essential position to the Brighton Senior Center will allow us to continue to grow our social, physical, health & wellness and educational offerings and services to the rapidly growing senior population in Livingston County.

With the addition of a part-time activities coordinator, we expect to accomplish the following 4 goals over the next 3 years:

- (1) Increase membership, effectively allowing us to service more area seniors.
- (2) Extend our service hours, including; returning our current daily hours (9am-2pm) back to pre-covid hours (9am-4pm), adding Friday hours, and some evening and weekend hours to accommodate all ages of the senior population.
- (3) Provide additional activities and services, including; arts & craft classes, cooking & nutrition classes (some will be in collaboration with Gleaners), technology & social media assistance, organized day trips, and expanding our fitness offerings.
- (4) Increase our event and social offerings by adding; evening & weekend events such as dinners, dances, open mic nights, social mingles and more.

Measurable Impact: (List quantitative/ qualitative metrics for the Goals outlined above)

To measure success, staff will compare program participation levels against yearly objectives and against previous year's levels. Based on the goals outlined above we expect to:

- (1) Increase membership by 20% each year.
- (2) Expand service hours by 4-5 hours each week, each year (for a total of 12 (minimum) additional service hours over 3 years).
- (3) Add 1-2 new programs/activities to each of the above categories each year (for a total of 15 (minimum) new programs/activities over 3 years).
- (4) Add 3-4 daytime events and 2-3 evening/weekend events each year (for a total of 9 (minimum) daytime and 6 (minimum) evening/weekend events over 3 years).

Please share how this Project would complement Senior Services in Livingston County?

The Fowlerville senior center for the past twenty years has solely operated under volunteers. Beginning January 2023, Livingston County Catholic Charities received a two-year grant to provide a program staff member to the Fowlerville Senior Center. The position is to provide support to the Director of the center and their board. Our senior center would like to add a variety of programs that will allow seniors in Fowlerville and beyond to have their social, recreational, health and educational needs met. We will be distributing surveys on a Likert scale that indicates satisfaction in regards to the new programs. The survey will also include open-ended questions for qualitative feedback. The programs that we are looking to implement are evidence based. The programs we plan to implement are within four different categories. Health and Wellness, Recreation, Events, and the Arts. In our health program, we are looking to start regular blood pressure checkups, elder abuse prevention speakers, Medicare and Medicaid trainings, personal tax workshops and exercise classes. Within our Recreation program, we want to continue our card games and dice games, but start new games including puzzles, corn hole, and book clubs. The events we are looking to start will be educational for our seniors. Some examples include the Henry Ford Museums, Meijer Garden and the Howell Nature Center. Finally, in the Arts program, one of our goals is to have regular music based activities. Numerous studies have indicated how music has positive effects on older adults, especially in cognitive functioning. A more recent study highlighted how music has short term and long term effects on older adults and can improve memory and emotional regulation (Abrhan, Shifres, & Justel, 2019). Providing these additional programming will assist in increase membership for the center and a stronger presence in the community.

Another focus during this two-year period is for the program staff to provide outreach and relationships on the senior centers behalf. Outreach that includes local business, churches and other entities for future sponsorships and connections to support the continued financial support for programming at the center. Livingston County Catholic Charities is committed to researching and applying for available grants to help support for future programming at the center during this time. We will also begin to engage and build stronger relationships with city and township officials as well as local community leaders to educate them on the importance of supporting the Fowlerville Senior Center.

The Hamburg Senior Center has seen significant membership increase in the last two years doubling in size. With the increased membership, we need portable walls to accommodate greater programming, new chairs to meet membership demands, and a handicap accessible door for safer access and exit to the outside patio. We would like to replace the original flooring throughout the building. The flooring is over 30 years old and is failing in areas. It also requires frequent stripping and waxing with chemicals and fumes that are difficult on our members with breathing difficulties.



Attached are two options for doors at the Senior Center.

E1952: "equal" pair of doors, each door is standard 36" wide. It is more expensive to do this option, but you could exit through either door. \$9442 installed.

A powered door operator would be on the Left door when viewed from outside. A bollard post would be installed approx 5' from the opening, so that when entering from the patio, seniors won't have to step backwards when the door opens under power. \$3124 installed

The photo below is from the attached spec sheet. In your case, the lock cylinder / active door would be the left door instead of the right door.



E1953 is for "unequal" pair of doors. The Left door when viewed from outside would be 42" wide. This extra width means seniors have plenty of room, wheelchairs aren't constrained by the opening, and of course either option has a smooth transition threshold that is ADA compliant. The right door when viewed from outside is 30" wide, and functions as a sidelight that can be unlatched manually and opened if needed for a delivery, etc. to get the full width of the opening. \$9167 installed

The powered operator option is the same price, and is \$3124 installed.

The doors are made in Detroit, the handicap operator is made in Texas. Lead time has been verified and is about 4-5 weeks as the doors are made to size. The operator is in stock. Our operator does not require extra force when used manually. I feel this is an important distinction that is overlooked, and many times operators require more force when used manually.

We put on several large performances in the Hartland Performing Arts Center and it requires many head mics for the musicians and the actors. *These shows have been are biggest fundraisers in the past (ranging from 10-20k each year). However, our existing head mics are quite old and we have frequency issues as well as the connection issues between the mic packs and the actual mics.

Measurable Impact: (List quantitative/ qualitative metrics for the Goals outlined above)

Since we track our average daily attendance and membership numbers, we will be able to measure an increase in participation across the board. We'll strive for at least a 10% increase in overall program attendance.

Measurable impact with regards to our head mics will be challenging but I can guarantee our audience, who is mainly seniors, will be able to hear our performers a lot better. Our volunteer performers will also be happier without having to deal with mics that cut out mid-sentence or battery packs that are missing the back panels etc.

Please share how this Project would complement Senior Services in Livingston County?

I'm confident these requests will not only improve the aesthetics of our center but also the functionality as these tables are flip top tables and chairs will also include moving carts. Our main senior center space needs to be welcoming and comfortable without the fear of a chair back breaking when they sit down and lean back or having a table tilt as they lean on it to stand up. Overall, these Year 1 items would improve the safety and look of our main space. The remaining Year 2 and 3 items are looking to the future for increasing overall participation in all our programs and events therefore increasing our revenue streams.

With our registration system we are able to pull reports of membership check-ins. We are able to pull reports by the year, month, day, and even hour. In addition to being able to pull reports, the senior center does annual surveys to ensure our goals are being met. For programs and events, we plan our programs out for the year to ensure we have adequate programming that focus on social, physical, and mental wellness along with education.

Please share how this Project would complement Senior Services in Livingston County? New Fitness Instructors- Our senior fitness classes are our fastest growing senior program. Our fitness classes allow seniors to engage in physical activity in a safe environment and instruction on proper technique. Our chair yoga class, tai chi, and stretch and strength all help with balance, range of motion, and mental wellness. While our senior strength class uses weights to help senior maintain their muscles which is important for everyday living. We have had such high demand in our classes are they are consistently hitting their maximum number of participants. We are looking to add 3 new classes which the budgeted amount will help with instructor fees for those new classes. With a large amount of participation, we also need to purchase new fitness equipment to be used in those classes such as yoga straps and blocks, resistance bands, and more weights. This amount is also budgeted but any additional cost will be covered by participant fees.

Transportation- Our travel program is our #1 requested programs by our seniors. Based on current quotes the average cost of a bus charter is \$900. Since this is just an average and some charters may cost more than others; the registration fee for the trip will cover a portion of the charter cost along with any admission and meal fees. These trips allow seniors who are unable to drive long distances to participate, engage with peers, and reduce their isolation. The remainder of the budgeted transportation funds will be used in partnership with LETS. This new partnership will allow seniors to have free transportation to our senior for big events and senior exercise classes. This helps seniors stay active in their community and stay active in their own lives.

Programs/Projects- One of our most popular programs is our Lunch and Learns. This program allows our seniors to learn about new subject matter on a variety of new topics and have lunch! Our seniors love continuing their education and are always suggesting new topics they want presentations on. A portion of this budgeted amount will cover the cost of the average presenter fee. The miscellaneous section will cover a new coffee machine and carafes, craft supplies, and special events costs such as our Thanksgiving and Christmas luncheons. Any other cost that goes over the budgeted amount will be covered by our registration fee.
