Resolution Authorizing Information Technology Upgrades at the new Fowlerville EMS Base and the distribution of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funds - Emergency Medical Services

**WHEREAS,** the EMS department was allocated ARPA funds by the board of commissioners for the purpose of adding rural EMS bases; and
