Resolution authorizing the submission of the Cooperative Reimbursement grant application for fiscal years

2024-2028 to the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services

The current Agreement and 2-year renewal between the Michigan Department of Health & Human Services (MDHHS) and the Livingston County Prosecuting Attorney expires on September 30, 2023. Under this Agreement, the Prosecutor's Family Support Division is required to comply with Title IV-D standards that relate to establishing paternity and obtaining child support orders. This function is a mandate of the Social Security Act as implemented by the State of Michigan through the Office of Child Support (OCS). Pursuant to the current Agreement, the State reimburses the County 66% of the costs associated with the services provided by the Family Support Division.

MDHHS now proposes a new 5-year contract for fiscal years 2024-2028 set to begin on 10-01-2023 and ending 09-30-2028. As in previous years, the proposed contract sets forth yearly allocations, including the 66% reimbursement to the County from the State. The respective allocations are as follows:
