RE: Resolution Authorizing the Purchase of Boiler Systems and Components

As part of the 2023 Budget and Capital Improvement Plan, Facility Services was allocated the estimated \$168,000 to complete boiler system and component replacements.

This project will replace the very aged domestic hot water boiler that supplies approx. 70% of the Jail inmate and staff areas. This project will also replace old and worn boilers for HVAC systems at the Administration, and Judicial Center buildings.

Typical life expectancy for these types of commercial boilers is around 15 years, and the boilers being replaced are all 20+ years old.

The total estimated cost of this project is \$169,105, and all quotes will be attached to the resolution packet. Per the resolution, I have requested a "cost not to exceed \$170,000" for this project.
