Resolution to Apply for Michigan Department of Health and Human Services Funding to Support Livingston County Health Department’s Response to Emerging Threats for the period of October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2024 – Health Department

WHEREAS, Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) has received funding to provide local health departments with capacity to respond to communicable diseases and environmental emergencies (Emerging Threats); and

WHEREAS, Livingston County Health Department has been notified by MDHHS of anticipated funding for October 1, 2023 – September 30, 2024 by MDHHS in the following projects

WHEREAS, the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services funding is designed to be flexible to allow Local Health Departments to respond to emergency threats in our community and allow for a timely reimbursement for training, equipment and staff resources; and

WHEREAS, the response activities will continue to align with the parameters set forth in Resolution 2021-09-156; and

WHEREAS, the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services may propose future amendments for the purpose of revising the funding or terms of the agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Livingston County Health Department will seek Board approval for the acceptance of funds.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Livingston County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Health Officer to apply for funding with Michigan Department of Health and Human Services to respond to communicable diseases and environmental emergencies in Livingston County October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2024.
