Resolution Authorizing Submission of the FY 2024 Child Care Fund Budget to the State of Michigan – Juvenile Court

- WHEREAS, the Courts, Public Safety, Infrastructure Development Committee of the Livingston County Board of Commissioners has reviewed and recommended approval of the submission of the FY 2024 Child Care Fund Budget to the State of Michigan for the period of October 1, 2023 September 30, 2024; and
- **WHEREAS,** the proposed budget is in the total amount of \$2,956,176 less anticipated revenue of \$95,000 for a proposed net expenditure of \$2,861,176 to be cost shared with the State of Michigan; and
- WHEREAS, with the advent of Raise the Age on October 1, 2021, the cost share for Juvenile Justice Intensive In-Home Services and Out-of-Home Service in FY 2024 will remain 50 / 50 for juveniles 16 and younger and the County / Court will receive 100% reimbursement for juveniles age 17 at the time of offense; and
- WHEREAS, the Child Care Fund Budget \$2,956,176 is comprised of three components: Court & DHHS In-Home Care Programs (\$1,700,186); Court Out-Of-Home Care (\$355,990) and MDHHS Out-Of-Home Care / State Ward Board & Care (AKA The Chargeback) (\$900,000).
- **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Livingston County Board of Commissioners hereby approves the submission of the FY 2024 Child Care Fund Budget as outlined.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chairman of the Livingston County Board of Commissioners is authorized to sign all forms, assurances, contracts, agreements, and future amendments for monetary and contract language adjustments, and supporting documents related to the FY 2024 Child Care Fund Budget for submission to the State of Michigan upon review and/or preparation of Civil Counsel.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Livingston County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes any budget amendment to effectuate the above.
