Resolution Authorizing the Distribution of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funding to Brighton Area Schools to Establish a JROTC Program at Brighton High School — Board of Commissioners

WHEREAS, Brighton Area Schools is requesting a \$150,000 grant from Livingston County's American Rescue Plan Act funds to launch a Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC) program to be housed at Brighton High School beginning in the 2024-25 school year; and

**WHEREAS,** this is an eligible use of ARPA funding and will be listed under the *Expenditure Category 6.1: Provision of Government Services* for federal reporting purposes.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Livingston County Board of Commissioners hereby approves the distribution of ARPA funds to the Brighton Area Schools in the form of a single grant that will not exceed \$150,000 in total for the sole use to launch a Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC) program, contingent upon Brighton Area Schools receiving approval from JROTC and implementing the program in the 2024-2025 school year.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board of Commissioners authorizes any budget amendments needed to effectuate this project.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that from the date of approval of this resolution until the project is completed, as outlined in Resolution 2022-12-192, the Brighton Area Schools shall provide a written update on the status of the project every three (3) months and shall present, in person, to the Finance and Asset Management Committee every six (6) months until the project is complete.
