Resolution Approving the Distribution of American Rescue Plan Act Funding to Purchase Mobile Scanners – Sheriff

WHEREAS, Resolution 2022-12-192 outlined a plan for the strategic use and distribution of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding; and

WHEREAS, a total of \$1,750,000 of ARPA funding was identified for the Livingston County Sheriff's Office for projects; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office is requesting \$16,995 of this allocation for the purpose of purchasing mobile scanners from Metrasens of Naperville, IL, which will be used to detect mobile phones and weapons at the Livingston County Jail; and

WHEREAS, this is an eligible use of ARPA funding and will be listed under the *Expenditure Category: 1.4 COVID-19 Prevention in Congregate Settings* for federal reporting purposes.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Livingston County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the amount of \$16,995 of ARPA funds for mobile scanners, to be provided by Metrasens of Naperville, IL.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chair of the Livingston County Board of Commissioners is authorized to sign all forms, assurances, contracts/agreements, and future amendments with contract language adjustments related to above upon review and/or preparation by Civil Counsel.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any subrecipient or contractor receiving ARPA funds must have an assigned Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) provided by SAM.gov.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners authorizes any budget amendments needed to effectuate the above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that from the date of approval of this resolution until the project is completed, as outlined in Resolution 2022-12-192, the Sheriff's Office shall provide a written update on the status of the project every three (3) months and shall present, in person, to the Finance and Asset Management Committee every six (6) months until the project is complete.
