Resolution Authorizing the EMS Department to Apply for the State of Michigan Emergency Medical Service Workforce Support Grant 2025 – Emergency Medical Services

WHEREAS, Livingston County EMS currently hosts EMT, Paramedic and Instructor Coordinator programs; and

WHEREAS, Livingston County EMS wishes to apply for grant funding to reduce or eliminate the student cost of these programs to the students; and

WHEREAS, Livingston County EMS identified a potential funding source to help cover these costs in the State of Michigan's Emergency Medical Service Workforce Support Grant covering the period of October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, if approved and awarded this grant could cover the cost of the tuition for most of our planned initial education programs for 2025; and

WHEREAS, the proposed application is for a funding award of \$329,700 covering tuition costs and draft budget attached; and

WHEREAS, there are no additional positions requested, nor a County match requirement; and

WHEREAS, if awarded, a resolution to accept the funds will be brought before the Board of Commissioners.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Livingston County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the EMS department to apply for the State of Michigan's Emergency Medical Services Workforce Support 2025 Grant (RFP number WEMSS-2025) covering the period of October 1, 2024 to September 30, 2025 in the amount of \$329,700.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Livingston County Board of Commissioners is authorized to sign all forms, assurances, contracts/agreements, renewals and future amendments for monetary and contract language adjustments related to the above upon review and/or preparation of Civil Counsel.
