Resolution Authorizing the Return of Community Development Block Grant Program Income to the State of Michigan – Fiscal Services

- WHEREAS,** the County participated in the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) since 2000; and
- WHEREAS,** the CDBG program allowed for emergency repairs and rehabilitation projects for low-income homeowners; and
- WHEREAS,** the homeowners received very low to zero interest rate loans that are repaid to the County, resulting in grant program income; and
- WHEREAS,** the Michigan State Housing Development Authority (MSHDA) is the grantor for CDBG. Guidelines require program income received in any grant fiscal year (July to June) in excess of \$35,000 be returned to the State of Michigan. If program income is less than \$35,000 in any grant fiscal year, the funds are no longer federalized and can be transferred to the County’s General Fund and spent for any purpose; and
- WHEREAS,** the County submitted program income certification for grant fiscal year 2023 to the State of Michigan. The County is required to return \$54,640.88 of program income to the State of Michigan.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners authorizes the return of CDBG program income in the amount of \$54,640.88 for grant fiscal year 2023 to the State of Michigan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners authorizes the return of grant program income to the State of Michigan where we have received more than \$35,000 in any grant fiscal year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners authorizes the transfer of defederalized program income to the General Fund in any grant fiscal year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners authorizes any budget amendment to effectuate the above.
