Resolution Authorizing an Additional Contribution to MERS for the Veterans Non-Union Division Fiscal Year 2025 – Veteran Services

- **WHEREAS,** a fundamental objective of the Livingston County Board of Commissioners as an employer that offers pension benefits, is to fund the long-term cost of the benefits promised to our employees: and
- **WHEREAS,** eliminating or reducing long term liabilities by making additional payments to MERS is a priority as it affects both the financial health and sustainability of Livingston County; and
- **WHEREAS,** Resolution 2023-11-192 carved out and created several new non-General Fund non-union divisions including Veterans Services; and
- **WHEREAS,** an annual actuarial valuation was completed for all divisions, including Veterans Services, which reflects an unfunded liability of \$318,915 as of 12-31-2024 for this non-union division; and
- **WHEREAS,** Veterans Services would like to pay \$318,915 off their long-term liability so annual required contributions will be reduced and primarily based on the service credit earned each year by active participants in this division; and
- WHEREAS, there are several advantages to making additional payments to MERS including: 1) reducing or eliminating the total unfunded pension liability 2) reducing future annual required contributions (ARC) and 3) additional assets to invest with the potential of a greater return than one would expect to earn in a traditional municipal operating investment; and
- **WHEREAS,** currently there are sufficient funds in Veterans Services fund balance to make an additional payment equal to the most currently reported unfunded liability for this Division in the amount of \$318,915.
- **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Commissioners hereby authorize a one-time additional payment to MERS for the Veterans Services Non-Union division in the amount of \$318,915 to be made from F295 Veterans Services Fund Balance.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** the Board of Commissioners authorizes any budget amendments needed to effectuate the above.
